### BROTHERHOOD CONVERSION WHAT'S THE BIG DEAL ?

There's always a lot of talk about Brotherhood Conversion. Just what is it, and why is it so important to the Lodge? Many people don't realize it, but you have not fully realized the meaning and purpose of OA until you have "sealed your membership" by accepting the principles of the Order and becoming a Brotherhood member.

As an Ordeal member, you are told what the OA is all about. Brotherhood is your way of saying "Yes, I want to live my life following the high ideals of an Arrowman." You are eligible to take your Brotherhood test after 10 months of Ordeal Membership. The requirements and information needed to pass your Brotherhood

can all be found in your OA Handbook. There is also information on our Web Page. Please note that the additional cost for the weekend covers your Brotherhood sash, flap pin, etc.

Brotherhood Conversion is also a key factor in the Lodge obtaining Honor Lodge status. It's not the numbers that should be the goal though. A decision to seal your membership is a sign of strength in the Lodge and of your dedication to the purposes of the Order.
