March 21, 2021

Officer Reports

Chief: Lodge Chief Avery Millisock had nothing new to report.

Vice Chief of Administration: Vice Chief of Administration Jeffrey Davenport reported that the Centennial Committee had a successful meeting this month.

Vice Chief of Activities: Vice Chief of Activities Cooper Dunn had nothing new to report.

Vice Chief of Inductions: Vice Chief of Inductions Jaydon Hensinger was not present.

Secretary: Secretary Samuel Mitten presented the February LEC Meeting minutes. Cooper Dunn made a motion to approve, and Jeremy Kirlin seconded. The motion carried and the minutes were approved.

Treasurer: Treasurer Christopher Kochel did not receive the information from council to complete the February cashflow report, so he will present both the February and March reports at the next LEC.

Committee Reports

Vice Chief of Administration Led

Centennial: Jeffrey Davenport reported that the Centennial Committee held a meeting on 3/4. The next meeting is 4/1. Elangomat: Jacob Keller reported that 2 new Elangomats were trained on Feb 28. He is working with the Elangomats to start calling their assigned candidates to encourage them to come out for their ordeals.

Old Business

Summer Chieftain: Avery is still looking for a Summer Chieftain applicant. Some lodge members have already applied for camp staff. The decision will be made by the April Weekend.

Officer Training: The officers had training on March 13th. They identified strengths and weaknesses of the Lodge and created plans to solve them. Some plans are being executed now.

Vigil Selection: The committee has been selected and they will be meeting shortly to select the Vigil class.

April and May Weekends: These weekends will be run the same way as the September Weekend. The Quarterly Meeting will be held over zoom on Sunday.

Momentum Discover: Registration is available on NOERS for Momentum Discover. It is a 2 day virtual training program run by National.

New Business

NOAC: NOAC 2022 is happening. It will be at the University of Tennessee.

National CoC: There will be a National Council of Chiefs meeting in August. Approvals will need to be made to fund the Chief to go. The approximate cost for the event would be \$800 for the event, including transportation. Avery Millisock made a motion to approve an \$800 fund, and Jeff Davenport seconded it. The motion carried and the Chief will be funded.

Proposed Bylaw Changes: Avery summarized the bylaw changes that will be presented in April. These include a change in Lodge leadership calendar to Jan-Dec, the subsequent changes that come to election dates, the addition of the Elangomat Committee, and some additions to the bead awards. In the transition period, the next Officer slate will be 6 months long. Cooper Dunn made a motion to send out the

proposed changes and vote on them in May, and Avery Millisock seconded. The motion carried.

Advisor Remarks

Lodge Advisor: Lodge Advisor Glenn Piper asked the LEC to promote the AT project to get the first Centennial event done. We need to work to make sure that those elected in 2020 can take their ordeal in 2021. We need to do the same for the 2021 candidates. Candidates are invited to the AT service project.
