Membership Report

The Membership Committee has been busy over the summer months processing late dues renewals, transfers, and members who have completed their Brotherhood honor at Summer Camp, and mailing out membership cards as necessary.

We have also recently completed a membership audit. This process verifies that our members are in good standing with the BSA. There are 53 members who paid dues who do not show up on the roles of the BSA for one reason or the other. Remember you must be a registered member of the BSA to be in the Order. We will be following up with all of these members before the end of the summer. We are also working on resolving some other problems found in the records after the audit.

"Houston ... We have a problem!" We have far fewer member renewals this year than last year! As of July, we are down close to 120 members from last year. This is mainly due to formerly paid members not renewing their dues. Membership numbers are extremely important in our effort to meet our "Journey To Excellence" award. Last year was the first in many years that we did NOT make the standard. Unless things change dramatically, our membership numbers will hold us back from the honor again this year.

What can you do to help? ... I'm glad you asked!

There will be another reminder mailing going out shortly to people who have not paid 2013 dues. If you want to maintain continuous membership, you must keep your dues up-to-date. If you don't pay your 2013 dues, you will not receive a 2014 renewal notice next year. Troop O.A. Reps -- Please encourage the Scouts and Scouters in your units to pay them.

Also, be sure to have your elected candidates take their Ordeal in September. We have quite a number of those elected that have not signed up for the September Weekend. We wil be sending out a reminder to them as well.
